U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services

NO ONE will ask about your immigration status for testing alone.

USCIS announced that testing, prevention, or treatment for COVID-19 will **NOT** affect your ability to get a green card or obtain citizenship in the future.

Regardless of immigration status, it is **SAFE AND SMART** to seek care at public hospitals, emergency rooms, COVID-19 testing sites, free clinics, and community health centers.

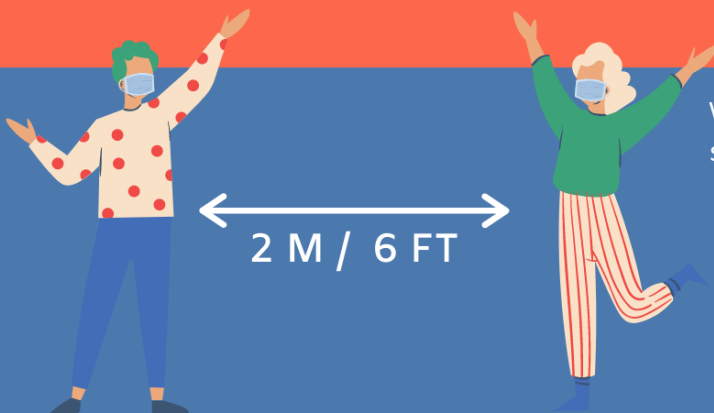
You can see a doctor without medical insurance.

If you don't qualify or cannot afford health insurance, enroll into NYC Care at 646-692-2273 or 311.

You do not need to share any information about your immigration status, unless you apply for Medicaid, Emergency Medicaid, or other health coverage for yourself.
